Readings at Mass

Cf. . Isa 30: 19, 30 Entrance Antiphon

O people of Sion, behold, the Lord will come to save the nations, and the Lord will make the glory of his voice heard in the joy of your heart.

First reading Isaiah 40:1-5,9-11

'Console my people, console them' says your God. 'Speak to the heart of Jerusalem and call to her that her time of service is ended, that her sin is atoned for. that she has received from the hand of the Lord double punishment for all her crimes.'

A voice cries, 'Prepare in the wilderness a way for the Lord. Make a straight highway for our God across the desert. Let every valley be filled in,

every mountain and hill be laid low.

Let every cliff become a plain, and the ridges a valley; then the glory of the Lord shall be revealed and all mankind shall see it; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken.' Second reading 2 Peter 3:8-14

There is one thing, my friends, that you must never forget: that with the Lord, 'a day' can mean a thousand years, and a thousand years is like a day. The Lord is not being slow to carry out his promises, as anybody else might be called slow; but he is being patient with you all, wanting nobody to be lost and everybody to be brought to change his ways. The Day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then with a roar the sky will vanish, the elements will catch fire and fall apart, the earth and all that it contains will be burnt up.

Since everything is coming to an end like this, you should be living holy and saintly lives while you wait and long for the Day of God to come, when the sky will dissolve in flames and the elements melt in the heat. What we are waiting for is what he promised: the new heavens and new earth, the place where righteousness will be at home. So then, my friends, while you are waiting, do your best to live lives without spot or stain so that he will find you at peace.

THE UNIVERSITY Sleep Transitions and Regularity Study
OF QUEENSLAND (STARs) We are currently recruiting families of children aged 9-12 months for an im-

portant new study of sleep transitions and regularity, and need your help. STARs is an exciting new study that aims to understand children's early day- and night-time sleep patterns and how sleep influences their learning, behaviour and health. STARs is a longitudinal study being conducted over a 4-year period. We will be recruiting families with children between 9 months to 12 months of age and following their development until they enter school (approx. age 5). Participation is voluntary and families are required to give online consent should they wish to participate. Families who agree to participate in the study will participate in activities that measure sleep, health and development. Due to the current social distancina requirements, communication will be conducted predominately remotely via emailonline platforms and telephone. This study is being run by researchers at The University of Queensland (UQ), led by Dr Sally Staton, Professor Karen Thorpe and Professor Simon Smith, in collaboration with the Australian Children's Education and Care Quality Authority (ACECQA), The University of Colorado (USA) and the University of Bristol (UK).
