The Catholic teaching: The Catechism of the Catholic Church summarizes the Church's teaching: "Divorce is a grave offense against the natural law. It claims to break the contract, to which the spouses freely consented, to live with each other till death..... Divorce is immoral also because it introduces disorder into the family and into society. This disorder brings grave harm to the deserted spouse, to children traumatized by the separation of their parents and often torn between them, and because of its contagious effect which makes it truly a plague on society" (CCC nos. 2384, 2385).

WHAT YOU CAN DO Test Yourself

The next time you are hurt by something your spouse has said or done, ask yourself:

- Am I overly sensitive?
- Is the offense so serious that I need an apologiy, or can l iust overlook it?

DISCUSS WITH YOUR SPOUSE

- How long does it usually take for us to forgive each other?
- What can we do to get to the point of forgiveness quicker?

TIPS

- When you are offended, do not attribute bad motives to your spouse.
- Try to excuse your spouse's behaviour, remembering that "we all stumble many times." James 3:2

"It's easy to foraive when we're both at fault, but it's more difficult when the offense seems one-sided. Accepting an apology and forgiving takes true humility." Kimberly.
