When I was in the seminary, I loved spending hours of prayer pondering the Mystery of the Trinity.

There's something about the unity and complete self-offering that my heart yearns to know and experience. I think there's a longing within many of us that desires the love-community of the Trinity. It's the only love triangle that works.

There's so many things to say about this feast and our God, but allow me to focus on one that has been a great source of vitality in my personal prayer. The Trinity in Creation.

The word Creation implies a Creator, and going back to the book of Genesis, we hear of the Word that spoke light and the Spirit that hovered over the waters. So already, at the origin of Creation, the Trinity has this governance and presence that is undeniably connected to whatever is created.

The author of a thing often leaves behind hints of the self that reflect an aspect of the way they view the world or their perspective on life, and so everything created thing has the remnants of the author, the artist, who in profound omniscience and creativity, established the order, beauty and wisdom of Creation. Godself can be known by reading the first book God spoke; the book of Creation.

Whether you're an avid mountaineer or bush walker, maybe you love the beach or rainforests of Northern Queensland, or perhaps the garden bed of roses at home in the backyard. Perhaps looking up at the night sky and seeing the wonder of the galaxy captures your imagination.

The pondering of beauty and excellence, as seen in the things that God has created, can help us delve more deeply into the Trinity. Above all, it leads us to experience one of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, that is, wonder and awe.

Creation has those 'take your breath' moments where we consider the magnificence of this world. I pray that the wonder and awe we feel for creation translates into wonder and awe for the majesty magnificence of the Triune God

## First Reading

The Wisdom of God cries aloud:

Bless the Lord, my soul. **R/**


All of these look to you



### Vinnies 2025 Winter Appeal

**Between January and May this year we made 366 visits.**
