Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Fear, stress, anxiety and worry these are the common words that we hear daily life. Today's gospel is about how Jesus healed the fear the apostles over the storm by rebuking the wind and the sea. They feared for their lives even though their Lord and Master was with them in the boat. They were asleep to Christ while he was present to them in their hour of need. The Lord Jesus is ever present to us. And in our time of testing he asks the same question: Why are you afraid? Have you no faith? There is one important lesson for each one of us in today's gospel story. Our lives are indeed a journey across the sea of time to the shore of eternity. During that crossing all who come to the use of reason encounter some storms. There is no smooth and calm crossing for anyone. Jesus in his life too had to face the storms in his life. On that night Jesus was aware of the coming of the storm and allowed the disciples to face it and only in their struggle he went to their aid. Do you recognize the Lord's presence with you, especially when you meet the storms of adversity, sorrow, and temptation? Whenever we encounter trouble, the Lord is there with the same reassuring message: "It is I, do not be afraid."

Jesus has given us the promise that he will be with us till the end of times taking care of us and protecting us from the storm. Lord Jesus, increase my faith in your redeeming love and power that I may always recognize your abiding

presence with me. And give me courage to do your will in all circumstances.

BATTLING VAD LEGISLATION WITH PALLIATIVE CARE PUSH

Queensland State MPs have the interval between now
and late August to weigh up how they will use their
conscience vote on the assisted suicide and euthana-
sia legislation (aka VAD legislation).

The church is not the only voice in this debate but it
doesn't deserve to be marginalised or openly ignored,
especially when its position supporting 'palliative care
first' is echoed by major medical providers (the Mater,
St Vincent's Healthcare, Southern Cross Aged Care),
as well as key peak bodies (Australian Medical Associ-
ation, Palliative Care Queensland, Catholic Health
Australia).

Each Parish has been sent an advocacy pack for a
'palliative care first' position and not VAD is available
in electronic form which will be shared
between now and the time of the vote (early Septem-
ber). If a significant number of parishioners heed its call
to contact their local MP's in person both via phone
and email and express their views, it may give the
member pause to reflect on how they will vote. If you
