Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe 21 Nov 2021 - Year B

Dear Parishioners

Happy Feast of Christ the Universal king to all. On the last Sunday of the liturgical year, the church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King to remind us of the all-embracing authority of Christ as King the Lord of the Universe.

This feast was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925 and is observed on the Last Sunday of the liturgical year it helps us to meditate on Christ the King and Lord and also on the Second and Final Coming of Christ, the Last Judgment. The feast of Christ the King was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925. In his encyclical letter Quas Primas the pope was addressing the spread of a climate in which respect for religion was waning in the western world.

People, including many Catholics, began to doubt both the authority and the very existence of Jesus Christ. Europe was also witnessing the rise of dictatorships, which were expounding the kind of propaganda that deceived people into placing more confidence in these narcissistic leaders than in spiritual values.

That was the right time to bring back people to the author ity of Christ needed reinforcement, was hoping to remind leaders and nations that they owed respect to Christ. More particularly, he wanted to institute a feast that would strengthen and encourage Catholics to allow Christ to reign in their minds, hearts, and whole lives (Quas Primas
