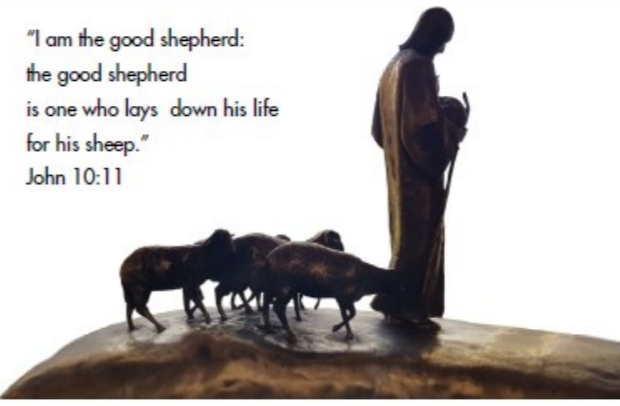

 John 10:11

What happens when April 25 falls on a Sunday as it does this year? no solemnity or commemoration can take precedence over a Sunday of the Easter season. Therefore the Anzac Day Mass cannot be celebrated this year as April 25 is the Fourth Sunday of Easter and the prayers and scriptural readings of the day take precedence over those set down for Anzac Day. A look at these texts, however, show that they are very appropriate for this special day of remembrance. The 1998 Apostolic Letter Dies Domini states this clearly in its first paragraph: "Sunday recalls the day of Christ's resurrection. It is Easter which returns week by week, celebrating Christ's victory over sin and death, the fulfilment in him of the first creation and the dawn of the 'new creation'."

we are kicking it off with our plant stall.

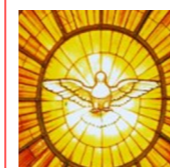
**We fondly remember Joan Martin who passed
