We give thanks to God as five Australian Capuchin novices were invested in the habit on Sunday, 22nd July. It is a very special moment in their vocational journey. They don the habit of St Francis after having spent time discerning with the Capuchins here in Australia, and then completing a year of Postulancy with the friars in Dutton Park, Brisbane. Invested in the habit, they are now referred to as "brother" and have begun their Novitiate year - which is done in California in collaboration with the Capuchin provinces of North America. God-willing, this time next year they will return to continue their formation here in Australia. Please keep them and all our young men in formation in your prayers.

The Capuchin Franciscan Friars are one of the largest men's Religious Orders in the Church, with more than 10,000 friars in over 100 countries. Inspired by St Francis of Assisi, we strive to live the Gospel of Our Lord Jesus Christ as a community of priests and brothers committed to a life of prayer, fraternity and ministry in simplicity, humility and joy. We profess vows of poverty, chastity and obedience, to follow as closely as possible Christ who was poor, chaste and always obedient to His Father in heaven.

# 2 Minute Catechism

## Why is the colour blue associated with Mary?

In the ancient world, the colour blue was associated with royalty. Beainning around A.D. 500, Mary is displayed in Byzantine art wearing a dark blue mantle, which is a sign of her royal dignity as queen. The association of Mary with the colour blue spread to the West and has continued throughout the ages.

# How old was Mary when she gave birth to Jesus?

We really don't know for sure. The great Jesuit, Francisco Suárez (1548-1617), who is considered the father of systematic Mariology, provides a survey of the Church Fathers and theologians on this issue in his 1592 treatise, "On the Mysteries of the Life of Christ." Suárez reports the consensus to be that Mary was around 14 when she conceived Jesus. He mentions that the Dominican theologian Cajetan believed Mary to be 19 to 24 when she conceived Jesus, but Suárez describes this as mere conjecture.
