2 Minute Catechism

The four principles of the church

When we recite the Nicene Creed during mass it encompasses the fundamentals of what Catholics believe in. The Creed further states that we believe in "One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church". Let's look at each of these.

One - Unified

A fundamental characteristic of the church is her unity. The church is united under the Magisterium of the Papacy. That is, there is a hierarchy headed by the Pope that unifies us. All successful organizations have someone who leads it. For Catholics this is the Pope – who we believe is guided by the Holy Spirit. This means that Catholics can assure themselves that the articles of faith are unified.

Holy - Sacred

We believe that mother church is Holy. It does not mean that all of us or our leaders are guaranteed to be holy. Since the Church is the bride of Jesus she is Holy – and is not dependent upon the holiness of mankind. For Catholics this means we can experience the holiness of the church in the celebration of the mass, sacred scriptures and in the unified Liturgy of the Hours prayers – just to name a few of the important ones

Catholic – Universal

The word Catholic itself means universal. The church is not limited to any country, race, nation nor culture. Today literally every spoken language in the world has been used in the celebration of the mass. The pope is the head of the church and is the bishop of Rome – but it is not just an Italian church. What it means to Catholics is that they can travel anywhere in the world and experience the mass. While the mass may be spoken in many languages – we all speak and hear the same language of Holy Mother Church.

Apostolic - Continuity

The word Apostle means sent forth – as Jesus sent the 12 Apostles forth to bring the Good News to the four corners of the earth. While Jesus had many followers or disciples, He handpicked 12 special men to build his church upon and told Peter that he was the "rock" of that church. Sacred scripture – particularly the Acts of the Apostles - and tradition provides Catholics with the history of the early church. Peter became the first "Pope" of the Catholic Church and his leadership was passed on to another man and to another man right up to modern times.

In a like manner the Apostles commissioned other men in their travels by the "laying on of hands" to assist in this effort. We call this "Ordination" today and it is one of the 7 Sacraments – which have continued on in every century since then. This means that Catholics can trace our origins and all of our priests can also trace their ordination back to the very beginning of Christianity – almost 2000 years ago.

We are One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic.

November Masses

These are offered for the living and the dead, our deceased relatives, friends and benefactors, and for those other deceased in need of God's mercy.

In November, the month of the Holy Souls, we especially pray for the Faithful departed. You can find the November envelopes at the entrance of the church or on the pews. The recommended minimum stipend for one November Mass (by Archdiocesan law) is \$20.

Please put the names of the deceased you wish to be remembered on the envelopes provided and place them in either Sunday collection.
