First Sunday of Advent 1st December 2024 - Year C

Friends,

Happy New Year! And by 'New Year', I mean **Liturgical** New Year. This weekend we begin the first Sunday of Advent, which also means the beginning of a new cycle of Sunday readings. We have now departed from St Mark's Gospel, Year B, and we begin St Luke's Gospel, Year C. Let me take the time to speak about St Luke and what we might expect as we move into this Liturgical New Year.

Most scholars believe that St Luke's Gospel was heavily influenced by St Mark. We see similarities between St Mark, St Matthew and St Luke - Gospels which are known to us as the Synoptics (**syn** means *together* and **optic** means *seen*). St Luke is traditionally credited as 'the beloved physician' (Col 4:14). He was a doctor by trade. He's believed to have written both the Gospel and the book of Acts. When you compare the opening lines of the Gospel and Acts, it's clear that they come from the same author. St Luke is focused on putting together an orderly account from the earliest eye witnesses of Jesus to show how the Lord fulfills the Jewish prophesies and came to redeem the world. He was an associate of St Paul the apostle and by the way he wrote predominantly for Gentile converts, we see how he was tied to the work of St Paul in his mission to the Gentiles. St Luke was believed to have compiled his work around 63-70 AD.

There are many things that are specific to St Luke that you won't find in the other Gospels. We hear of the census of Caesar Augustus. We hear of the journey to Bethlehem and the adoration of the shepherds. We have Jesus' presentation in the Temple and Simeon's proclamation. We have the famous Prodigal Son and Good Samaritan story and an account of Jesus' Ascension.

One of the strong themes in St Luke is what many might consider as the **Upside Down Kingdom**. This is presented mostly in St Luke's Sermon on the Plain (Lk 6). St Luke presents a God who reverses the value system of humanity to focus not on status, honour or power, but service, humility and radical generosity. Jesus calls his disciples to be people who forgive, make peace and reject religious hypocrisy.

As we begin this journey with St Luke, may we take the time to sit and reflect with these words and parables. May we find in this coming year, a new sense of mercy and forgiveness, service and humility and a commitment to Jesus' mission: to be witnesses to the things of Christ, to be clothed in the Holy Spirit and to spread this message of hope to all the world (Lk 24:48-49).

Finally, brothers, we urge you and appeal to you in the Lord Jesus to make more and more progress in the kind of life that you are meant to live: the life that God wants, as you learnt from us, and as you are already living it. You have not forgotten the instructions we gave you on the authority of the Lord Jesus.

Alleluia, alleluia! Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

Jesus said to his disciples: 'There will be signs in the sun and moon and stars; on earth nations in agony, bewildered by the clamour of the ocean and its waves; men dying of fear as they await what menaces the world, for the powers of heaven will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. When these things begin to take place, stand erect, hold your heads high, because your liberation is near at hand.

'Watch yourselves, or your hearts will be coarsened with debauchery and drunkenness and the

cares of life, and that day will be sprung on you suddenly, like a trap. For it will come down on every living man on the face of the earth. Stay awake, praying at all times for the strength to survive all that is going to happen, and to stand with confidence before the Son of Man.

Communion Antiphon:

The Lord will shower his gifts, and our land will yield its fruit.

Prayer after Communion:

Father, may our communion teach us to love heaven. May its promise and hope guide our way on earth.
